We are delighted to announce the launch of our new Monthly Carbon Intensity Indicator Evaluation Report, designed to assist you in effectively monitoring a vessel’s CII by providing you with valuable insights into your vessels’ environmental impact and progress towards sustainability goals.

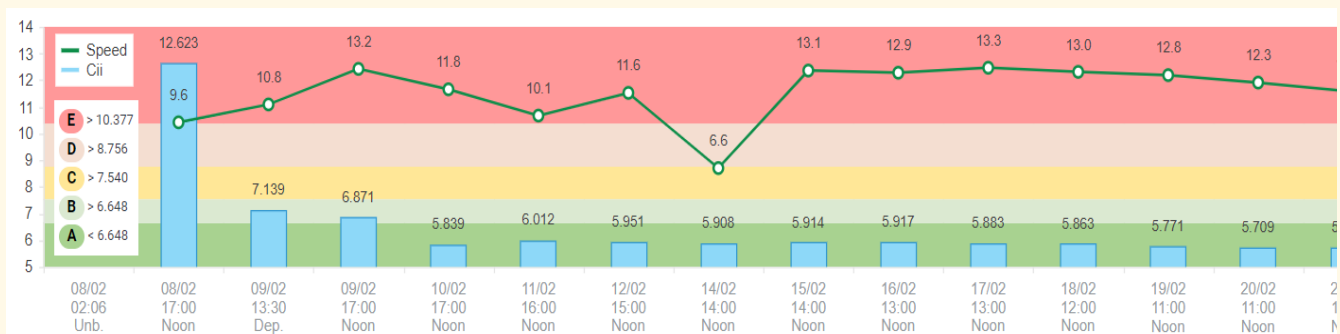
We firmly believe that this new report will be a valuable tool in your sustainability journey that will help you track the energy efficiency of your vessels, identify areas for improvement, provide you with valuable information on the energy efficiency of each vessel and help you make informed decisions about their present and future operations.

The Monthly Carbon Intensity Indicator Evaluation Report is available on the Owners’ Portal in the folder entitled ‘Vessel Performance’.

Our goal is to enhance the report with additional information relevant to each vessel’s performance accompanied by data visualisation charts of each vessel’s CII rating.

Please see below examples of what additions to expect in future reports:

- CII numerical score attained during each sea passage
- Sailed distance (nm)
- Average speed (kn)
- Average consumption of ME + AE (mt/24h)
- Average weather conditions (wind forces, wave, swell height) as reported by crew onboard
- Visual Data Representation, please see example below:



Example of a sea passage rated “A”. As a reminder, the required CII rating for all vessels is “C” as per IMO Regulations

Notes:

- Speed (kn) is represented by the green line
- CII numeric score per day is represented by the blue column
- Coloured background indicates the CII attained score per day basis the A – E scale
