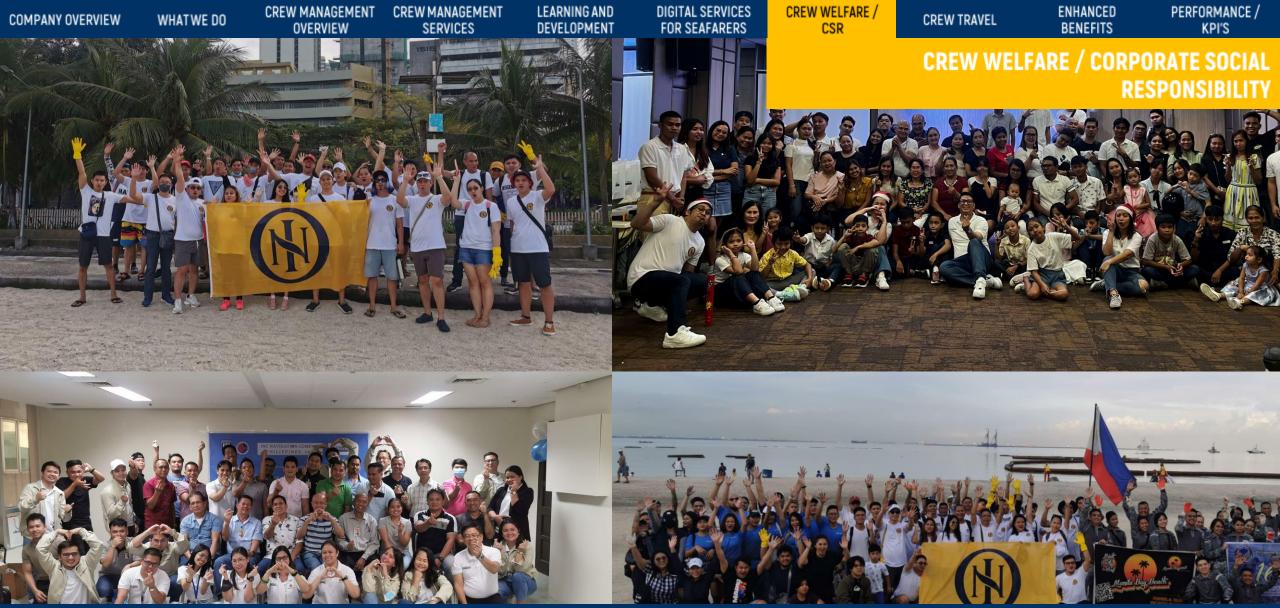

Managing Contracts and time



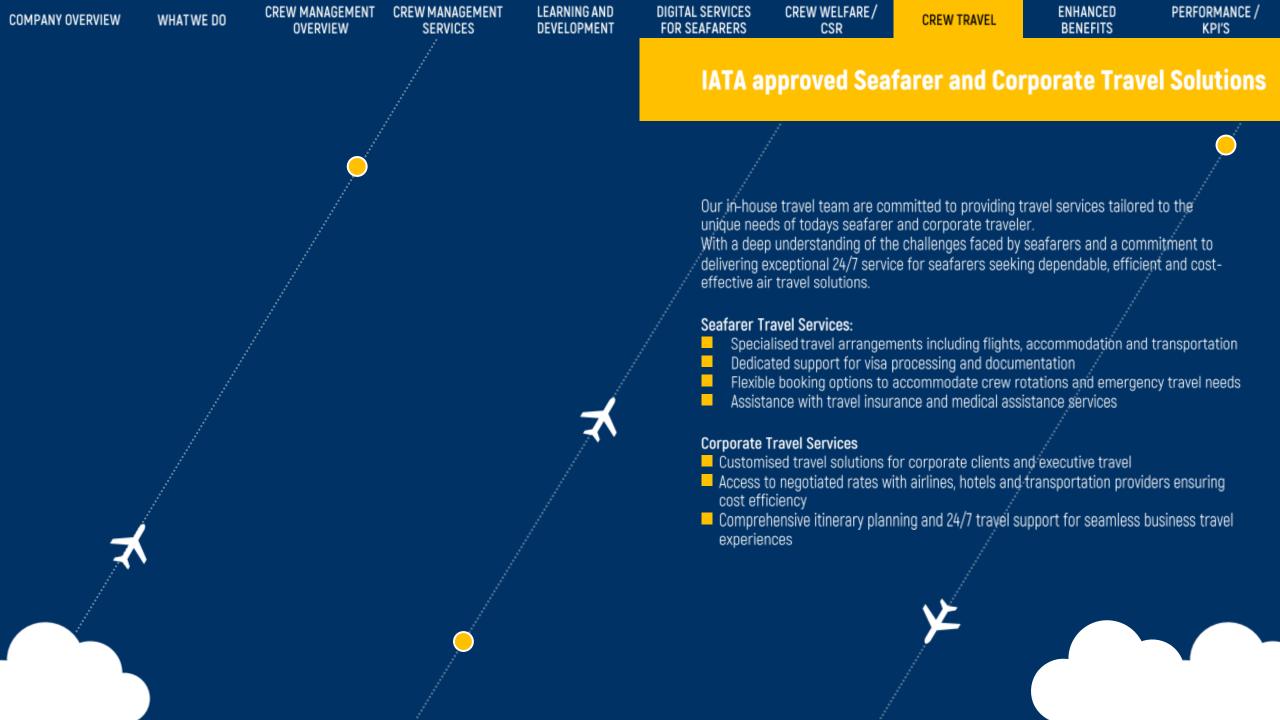
